Participate in the **FREE HOME ENERGY CONSERVATION PROGRAM** to reduce your utility bills, make your home more comfortable and reduce air pollution in our area.

Free Energy Upgrades

Have FREE energy upgrades done for your home. Trained installers will do the work.

- Weather-stripping
- Electrical wall plates insulated
- Window and door weather-stripping and caulking
- Water heater blankets
- Water-saving shower heads
- Energy-efficient lighting

The Home Energy Conservation Program is a partnership providing home energy improvements for low-income homeowners in the Sacramento area. Qualifying families are typically elderly, disabled or families with children.

Qualifications

- Income guidelines: up to approximately \$39,000 for a family of one; approximately \$55,000 for a family of four.
- Proof of income is required.

The three-page application includes income verification and answering a few questions such as whether SMUD or PG&E have installed energy conservation measures in your home, and whether your doors or windows are drafty.
